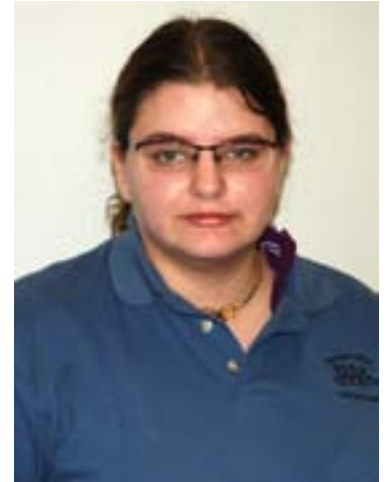


Students of the Month

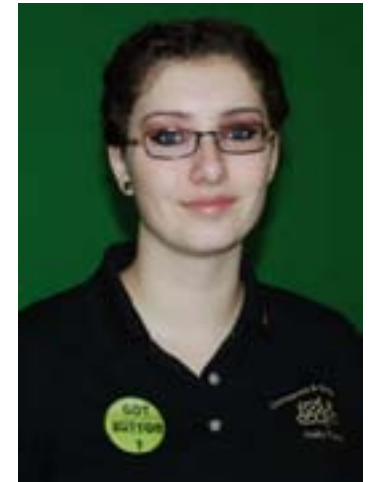

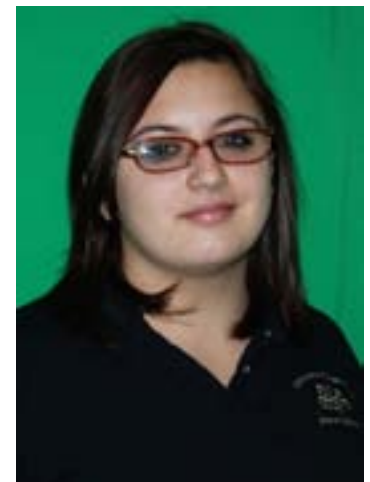
