Top 5 Four County Career Center Levy Facts:

1. **WHAT?** Four County Career Center will be placing a 0.2 mill addition Permanent Improvement Levy on the ballot for a continuing period of time. They have not asked for new money in twenty-three years.
2. **WHY?** The Levy is required for building maintenance, equipment replacement and facility construction. A front entrance will be constructed to improve security. The addition will include new classrooms for the increasing student population and a large multipurpose meeting room available for public use.
3. **WHEN?** District residents will vote on a Permanent Improvement Levy on Tuesday, November 8, 2011.
4. **WHERE?** At the ballot boxes in your precinct on Election Day.
5. **HOW MUCH?** The current 0.2 mill Permanent Improvement Levy will expire with the passage of this levy. The 0.2 mill levy will cost an additional 26 cents per month for the owner of a \$100,000 home.
