

Career & Technical Centers Professional Development Day

On Friday, September 28 employees from ten career & technical schools from Northwest, Northeast and Central Ohio, will jointly participate in a first-ever unified Professional Development Day. About 1,000 school employees, including teachers, administrators, secretaries and other support staff, will participate in the event at one of three sites. The locations of the Professional Development Day are: Penta Career Center in Perrysburg; Sentinel Career and Technology Center in Tiffin; and Tri-Rivers Career Center in Marion.

“After years of hosting professional development conferences for administrators from these same schools, it was suggested that we organize a conference that would benefit the entire staffs from each of the ten schools,” said Tim Meister, Superintendent of Four County Career Center. “Collaborating with our fellow colleagues provides us the opportunity to share ideas and develop new strategies that will ultimately benefit students in career and technical education.”

Some of the topics discussed during this event will include: Instructional Teaching Strategies, Certification Opportunities for Students, comparison of Subject Content, CPR Training, Career Testing Options, Student Evaluations, Student Organization Involvement, Career Program Promotion Events, Career and Technical Competencies, The use of Technology; and topics of importance to office staff.

The ten career and technical schools participating in the Professional Development Day include: Apollo Career Center in Lima, EHOVE Career Center in Milan, Four County Career Center in Archbold, Lorain County JVS in Lorain, Ohio Hi-Point Career Center in Bellefontaine, Pioneer Career & Technical Center in Shelby, Penta Career Center in Perrysburg, Tri-Rivers Career Center in Marion, Vanguard-Sentinel Career & Technology Centers in Fremont and Tiffin, and Vantage Career Center in Van Wert.
