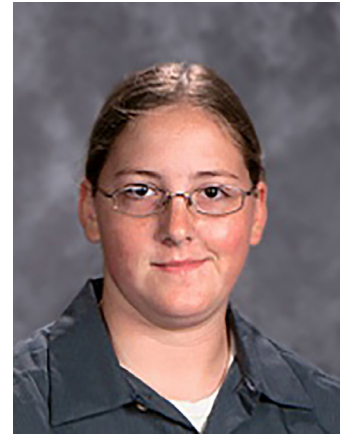
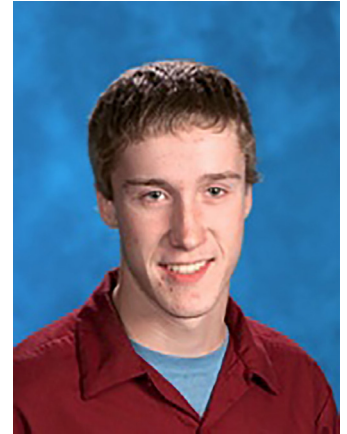


## Students of the Month - November

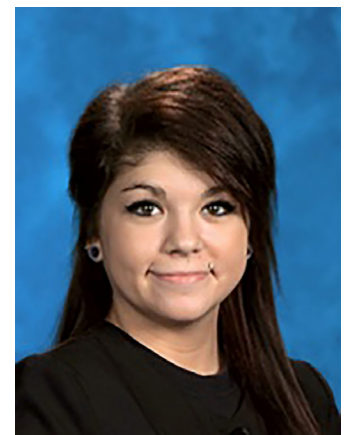
